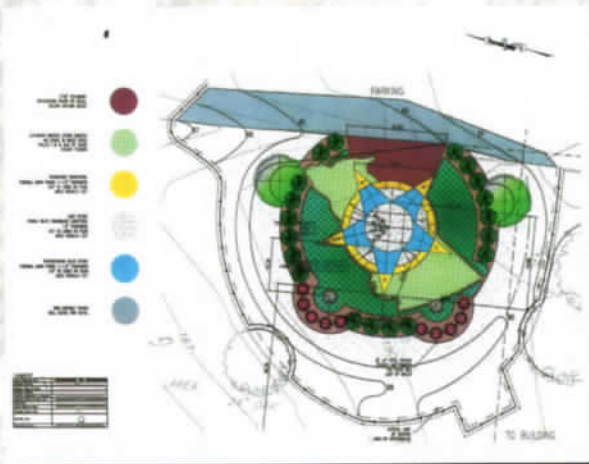
Bucks County FOP Lodge 53

The Bucks County Lodge has always maintained the aim to bond together every police officer of Bucks County in fraternity and friendship, to defend themselves and their interests when attacked, and gain all the rights to which they are entitled to as a member of a highly respected profession. Over the last 4 years, discussions have been taking place about how to best honor those, that have paid the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty. It is this reason, that the idea to create a memorial at the Lodge Home was decided. With the support of the communities we serve, we can forever remember, nor forget these Bucks County Heroes.

Bucks County Fraternal Order of Police Lodge 53 is in the process of establishing its first ever Police Memorial Site at its Lodge facility in Wycombe (Wrightstown Township, Bucks County) where the meetings of the Lodge and other functions are conducted monthly. Currently, the lodge boasts a membership in excess of 1,000 active members. Retired members number approximately 450 and associate members number 350.

At the present time, 13 law enforcement officers have paid the ultimate sacrifice and were killed in the line of duty protecting the citizens in Bucks County.
